

VODKA

Black Cow Pure Milk Vodka 40%, £3.20

The world's first pure milk vodka, made from nothing but pure whole Dorset milk. The whey is used for vodka whilst the curds go into award winning cheeses. Sweet creamy taste, subtle hints of vanilla and cinnamon



Brecon Five 40%, £3.10

A Welsh vodka, distilled at Penderyn from wheat and blended with fresh Welsh water from the Brecon Beacons.

Chase English Potato Vodka 40%, £3.40

The world's first super premium English potato vodka. Made on a farm in Herefordshire, from seed to bottle, giving a quality vodka with provenance.

Chase Bramley Apple 40%, £3.50

Bottle number 730 from a limited run of just 2,000 bottles. Made from Herefordshire Bramley apples grown on their own farm.

Naked Chase Apple Vodka 40%, £3.40

Made with apples from their Herefordshire orchards. A pure, fresh vodka, with a hint of apple on the nose.

Chase Smoked 40%, £3.40

Bottle number 925 from a limited run of just 1,000 bottles. Made with Herefordshire potatoes. The spirit is smoked with English oak for an exquisitely robust and evocative flavour.

Eristoff 37.5%, £2.90

A triple distilled Georgian vodka, named after Prince Eristoff, and based on his personal recipe, created in 1806. Very pure.

Ketel One 40%, £3.10

Meticulously-crafted vodka from a Dutch distillery that has remained a family business for ten generations since 1691. Introduced in the UK in 1999 after massive US success.



Naga Chilli Vodka (100,000 scovilles) 40%, £3.40 From the 'Hot Enough' Vodka Co.. Naga Jolokia (aka: Ghost) chillies are added to the vodka and left to infuse and impart their flavour, colour and deathly fire into the vodka.



Reyka Icelandic Vodka 40%, £3.20

Distilled from wheat and barley. It is also the world's first "green" vodka, being made from glacial water and distilled using sustainable energy from geothermal heat.

Russian Standard Vodka 40%, £2.90

Uniquely Russian in feel. A subtle, bread-like aroma coupled with the sterling crisp character of the winter grains both on the palate and in the finish. Russia's best selling.

Stolichnaya 40%, £3.10

The classic Stolichnaya Red Label vodka, filtered three times, once with quartz, then charcoal and then quartz again for a pure but original flavour profile.

Stolichnaya Hot Jalapeno 37.5%, £3.10

As above with little more than a hint of heat from Jalapeno chillies.

Sipsmith Barley Vodka 40%, £3.30

Distilled from English Barley. Epitomises distilling on a truly artisanal scale. The copper pot still was the first to be brought to life in London for over 200 years.



Smirnoff Number 21 (Red Label) 37.5%, £2.80

Triple distilled from a blend of grains, and filtered ten times through seven columns of environmentally sustainable charcoal, it's an exceptionally pure tasting, smooth spirit with a clear, crisp taste and a cool finish.

Wyborowa 40%, £3.10

A double distilled rye vodka from Poland. The emphasis is on quality – even its name means wonder'premium'. Full-bodied yet still extremely smooth,

Zobrowka Bison Grass Vodka 40%, £3.20

One of the most famous Polish vodkas out there, with its famous stem of Bison Grass in the bottle. Flavour profile suggests herbaceous notes, vanilla and spring flowers.

FRUIT VODKA

Chase Marmalade 40%, £3.50

Made with Seville Orange Marmalade. Clear with a golden hue. Strong orange zest on the nose, a naturally rich bittersweet flavour and a warm velvety mouth feel. Perfect over ice and with tonic.

Chase Rhubarb 40%, £3.50

Sweet & fruity Made by cooking the rhubarb, marinating it in vodka, distilling, then adding yet more macerated rhubarb and filtering it. This gives a lovely pink hue and wonderful flavours.

Sipsmith Damson Vodka 28%, £3.60

A sweetened infusion of Damsons in their barley based vodka for a clean fruity burst.
