Aureus Crémant de Loire, Blanc de Blancs brut 2002 £19.75

Loire, France. Complex aromas and fine flavours. Racy, pure fruit with a dry finish. Méthode Traditionelle.

Lunetta Prosecco Spumante brut £19.50

Veneto, Italy. Softly sparkling and refined. Deliciously light and fragrant.

CHAMPAGNE

Champagne Gremillet brut selection £33.25

France. Fine mousse and fresh, floral aromas. Well-balanced with a fine citrus finish. Great value.

Champagne Veuve Cliquot Ponsardin, Yellow Label brut £46.50

France. Classic, distinctive Champagne – one of the best. Complex, subtle yeast and biscuit flavours. Creamy, lingering dry finish.

Champagne Gremillet Rosé brut £37.75

France. Stylish hand crafted rosé from this excellent house.

RED WINES

Rioja, Vega del Rayo seleccionada 2007/08 £17.20

Rioja Alta, Spain. Smooth and sophisticated. Generous fruit and good length.

Juan Gil Monastrell-Monastrell 2009/10 £18.60

Jumilla, Spain. Full-bodied, warm and luscious. Added complexity and balance from exemplary oak ageing.

Novas Carménère/Cabernet Sauvignon 2008/09 £20.35

Chile. Vibrant, powerful organic red. A classic blend.

Vista Reserva TN, Figueira de Castelo Rodrigo 2005/06 £18.50

Beiras, Portugal. Great concentration and structure. Dark and brooding.

Barbera d'Asti Superiore, Alasia 2005/07 £18.95

Piedmont, Italy. Old vine Barbera, oak-aged for twelve months. Dry, but with sweet fruit flavour and soft tannins.

Peacock Ridge Merlot 2007/08 £20.60

Stellenbosch, South Africa. Dark, dense up front fruit balanced by fine, seductive tannins. Long, complex finish.

Cahors, Château Pineraié 2007 £22.75

South West France. Top-notch Malbec-based red. Tangy red berry fruit flavours and a delicious long finish of ripe cherries.

Mr Smith Shiraz, Rogue wines 2008/09 £25.25

South Australia. Impressive big-hitter. Loads of absurdly lush fruit.

Moko Black Pinot Noir 2009/10 £24.00

New Zealand. Elegant, and pleasingly fresh, with lovely strawberry fruit.

Cousiño Macul Antiguas Reserva, Cabernet Sauvignon 2005 £23.90

Chile. Complex, distinguished Cabernet from a beautiful old estate.

ROSÉ WINE

Viñedo No.5 Rosado, Bodega de Sarria 2009/10 £18.25

Navarra, Spain. Big-flavoured, concentrated rosado in the classic style of the region. Rich in ripe berry fruit with elegant floral notes.

WHITE WINES

Paarl Heights Chenin Blanc 2009/10 £14.75

Paarl, South Africa. Fresh and aromatic. Easy and versatile.

Ruviano Verdicchio, Monte Schiavo 2009/10 £15.90

Marche, Italy. Zesty citrus aromas. A bright and characterful wine.

Artesa Rioja Viura 2009/10 £15.65

Rioja Baja, Spain. 100% unoaked Viura. A modern, refreshing Rioja: the rounded richness of fruit balanced by clean, crisp acidity.

Pinot Grigio, I Mastri Vernacoli 2009/10 £16.65

Trentino, Italy. Stylish PG, dry yet gentle, with nutty and spicy overtones.

Picpoul de Pinet, Duc de Morny, Cave de l'Ormarine 2009/10 £17.90

Languedoc, France. Floral and enticing. Exuberantly fresh, concentrated fruit palate with an underlying dry minerality. Excellent long finish.

Vouvray demi-sec, les Côteaux Tuffiers 2003/05 £18.20

Loire, France. Honeyed mellow fruit, sweetness balanced by gentle acidity.

Tabalí Reserva Viognier 2010/11 £18.20

Chile. Beautifully aromatic, pure Viognier with mouthfilling, creamy texture. Off-dry and unoaked, soft and rounded. Real value.

Lugana Campo Valentino, Giacomo Montresor 2009/10 £21.20

Veneto, Italy. Elegant, light and dry. Lingering finish with a dash of citrus. A subtle, restrained wine – highly recommended.

Orballo Albariño, Bodegas La Val 2008/09 £22.40

Rías Baixas, Spain. Generous floral, citrus and mineral flavours; succulent, silky texture backed by lively acidity. A Galician classic.

Moko Black Sauvignon Blanc 2009/10 £22.50

New Zealand. Definitive Marlborough Sauvignon. Full, layered palate with hints of gooseberry and tropical fruit; clean, with good weight and balance.

APÉRITIF/DESSERT WINE

Monbazillac, Domaine de Grangeneuve 2005/07 (50c. bottle) £18.20

South West France. Luscious, ethereal and honeyed, with an elegant finish. Great with cheese, or enjoy it French style as an aperitif. Not sticky sweet.

FINE WINES – RED

Chianti Classico Riserva, Villa La Pagliaia 2000 £28.95

Tuscany, Italy. Archetypal Chianti. Classic Sangiovese flavours of brambly, bitter cherry fruit backed by succulent acidity and age-mellowed tannins.

Balgownie Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2005 £43.00

Victoria, Australia. Dark, sumptuous Cabernet from a famous, old estate. Juicy blackcurrant/chocolate/spice. Power tempered by finesse.

St Emilion Grand Cru, Clos de la Cure 2007 £41.95

Bordeaux, France. Complex claret of superb structure. Good fruit, solid, tight tannins and a long, satisfying finish.

Valenciso Rioja Reserva, Compañia Bodeguera de Valenciso 2004 £39.95

Rioja Alta, Spain. Pure Tempranillo: rich, elegant and beautifully understated. Combines the best of tradition with fine modern winemaking practice.

FINE WINES – WHITE

Sancerre “La Clochette”, Jean-Jacques Breton 2009/10 £25.15

Loire, France. Dry, crisp and refreshing Sauvignon Blanc. Flavour-rich palate with good gooseberry fruit and fine, well-balanced acidity.

Jurançon Sec, Domaine Bellegarde 2008/10 £32.35

South West France. Racy, citrus scented dry white. Delicious acidity, absolutely characteristic of the finest Jurançon. Delightful.

Yangarra Estate Roussanne 2009 £39.55

South Australia. A touch of Aussie class. Vibrant, spicy and refreshing.

Zellinger Himmelreich Riesling Spätlese, Markus Molitor 2004 £34.65

Mosel, Germany. Exciting wine: lovely lemon and ripe pear flavours. A vibrant mix of sweetness and acidity, ripeness and minerality.

Pernand Vergelesses Blanc, Vallet Frères 2006 £45.60

Burgundy, France. Proper Burgundy. Rich and complex. Great vintage.
